Elephant Thoughts – Riverstone Retreat

Ms Ryan's Grade 6 class was very honoured to be hosted by members of both Saugeen First Nation and Chippewas of Nawash Unceded First Nations for a day of traditional practices, storytelling, puppeteering, foraging, and reflection. Students experienced the sharing of a sacred elder bundle and were active in the experience of smudging, making medicine, and reciprocal exchange wherein they presented their hosts with handmade Tobacco ties made with ceremonial Tobacco (one of four sacred medicines). It was a special day that brought about higher level thinking and the importance of youth participation in the process of Truth and Reconciliation.
