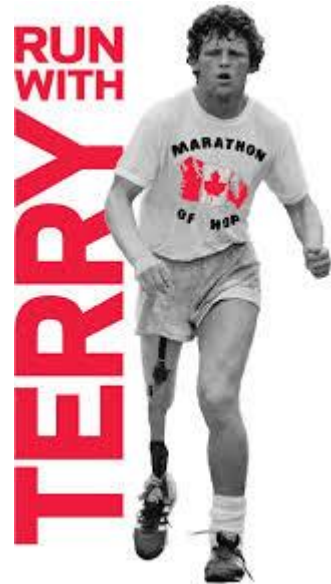
## Home & School
